If we then pay \$10 as coaches, our insurance will increase to 500,000

Track officials certification is available. \$20 to pay for test.  
8:30 to 1:15  
Attending two of four will meet the criteria for certification.

APS was at a session on how to use photo finishes as opposed to hand timing. Will use it but it will not be official yet.

Regional coaches of the year. History of there program not just one year.  
4 Names two for boys and two for girls.

Points of emphasis: FAT timing at the district

A meeting was held to discuss trying to implement the FAT.  
More difficult at smaller schools where there are more obstacles and more challenges to see this through.

Perhaps money should be set aside by the schools.

There does not have to be a specific system.  
If you purchase it you need to make sure you are trained. Make sure there is a training package.

Changing the 4 x 200 into a race in which teams run in lanes throughout the duration of the race.

Changing the 1600 to 1500 and 300H to 400H as it is in college as a means of better preparing our athletes for the next level.

Direct Athletics entries for the indoor must be done by the individual and not through the coaches
